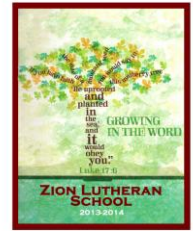

### Disciplining Is Teaching – From Parent Pages

Your children are your disciples. Parents are the model of what you want them to grow up to be. If these sentences are a bit scary, they should be. As parents, I think we all have some fear is to what kind of adults our children are going to grow up to be.

The answer to that fear is to pray. Pray fervently, pray often, pray with confidence that God stands ready to answer your prayer in ways that you cannot imagine. God loves you and chose you to be the parents of these children. He will gladly support you in the task He has assigned to you.

Here are some of the blessings God will use to answer your prayer for wisdom and guidance:

### **God will create a community of love and support.**

God will help you treat your children with respect and gently, but firmly, hold them responsible for treating you and other family members with equal respect. Your family should show and feel unconditional love for each other at all times.

### **God will give you honesty.**

God will help you be honest about your mistakes. Apologize and accept forgiveness. Explain why you were wrong and what you should have done instead.

### **God will bless your home.**

God will help you provide an environment that encourages your child to obey. Is there a temptation that your child is not mature enough to resist? Remove the temptation.

For older children, take care to watch and help them learn to resist. Know what is going on when you are with your children and when they are at school, child care, or a friend or relative's house. Take advantage of communication opportunities and develop relationships with the families and people who care for your child.
